### Policy Statement

An alumna/us (defined as having earned 12+ credits) may be eligible to receive certain benefits based on their alumni status.

### Rationale

Offering benefits to alumni draws them back to campus and shows an appreciation for their time spent on campus.

### Policy Procedures

Alumni benefits include the following:

- Three meal tickets per calendar year (per alumna/alumnus)
- One free night in the guestrooms per calendar year (per family)
- Discounted membership to the fitness center.
- Free access to the computer labs
- Access to the online job board
- Library guest pass
- One course audit per semester for application fee only. Some restrictions apply. They may only audit a course up to the level of their CIU obtained degree. ([Audit Policy Link](#))
