



International Citizens Certification of Funds

U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services' regulations require U.S. universities certify that admitted international students have sufficient funding to pursue a full course of study. In compliance with this regulation, Columbia International University requires international applicants to present documentation of financial resources adequate to cover all of their tuition and living expenses at the University for one academic year. Students are responsible to re-certify funds each year of study at CIU. The U.S. Embassy or Consulate in the student's home country may accept this form as adequate financial certification, and/or may request other documentation.
